Please note special information and instructions for each day.

Monday (Nov. 20): 2:15 pm to 4:00 pm. Parents, Guardians and students are welcome to come to the Book Fair during this time to preview books or to purchase books.

Tuesday (Nov. 21): 2:15 pm to 4:00 pm. Students will be able to preview books from the Book Fair during their library class. No books can be purchased during class time on this day. Parents, Guardians and students are welcome to come to the Book Fair after school to preview books or to purchase books.

Wednesday (Nov. 22): 2:15 pm to 4:00 pm. Students will be able to purchase books from the Book Fair during their library class. Parents, Guardians and students are welcome to come to the Book Fair after school to preview books or to purchase books.

Thursday (Nov. 23): 2:15 pm to 7:15 pm. Parents, Guardians and students are welcome to come to the Book Fair after school to preview books or to purchase books. As well, this is Parent Teacher Conference evening. We can all enjoy the Book Fair celebration together during this time!

Monday (Nov. 27): 2:15 pm to 4:00 pm. This is the last day of the Book Fair.

Dear Parents/Guardians: Your child's teacher and our much appreciated group of reading volunteers are launching a new home reading program. Today your child will be bringing home a book bag with two books which, to the best of our understanding, are at his or her reading level. Here are some instructions as to how this program works:

- 1) Please listen to your child read one or two of these books to you each night
- 2) Please initial the reading log contained in the book bag
- 3) Please review with your child any flashcards or alphabet sheets contained in the bag
- 4) Please ensure that your child brings the book bag back to school each morning to drop in the basket outside his or her classroom. Our reading volunteers will be checking the bag every day and making sure your child gets new books at least once a week.






