

Monday – Week 4 Focus on Vowels (aeiou)

**every English syllable (group/chunk of letters that make a complete sound)*

**It is also why some words have 2 of the same letter, or extra vowels that are silent (ex. last week, yel – low, or why lit – tle has an e at end, vowel required in every syllable)*

-print over all the Dolch words List 2

-cut them out, keep the scraps for Thursday

-play I Spy With My Little Eye (ie. a word that has the vowels (aeiou, sometimes y))

-keep all words in a bag/envelope/folded paper for weeks to come

Tuesday

-sort the words by first vowel (ex. away – would be first a, but so would far, because of the a)

Wednesday

-sort the words alphabetically (a words then b words...)

Thursday

-use the words to make sentences (you can print extra words on scraps of paper or place toys beside words for extra nouns; you may use scraps of paper to give endings ie./ s, ed, ing)

Friday

-make a story from as many words as possible

-take a picture of your story
