Step 1: Digging the holes for the rebar cages and concrete footings

Structure Work in Progress



Step 2 – The rebar cages and sonotubes are filled with concrete to hold the timbers in place for the structure. A strong foundation indeed! Once the concrete is set it's time to backfill and get ready to build!



Step 3: The Support Beams and Roof Trussees
